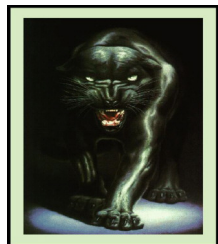




Plant High School Sailing Club 2009-2010 Season



The H.B. Plant High School Sailing Club, supported by the Davis Island Youth Sailing Foundation (DIYSF) at Davis Island Yacht Club (DIYC), offers the opportunity for high school students to enhance their skills at sailing and compete on the H.B. Plant team in the Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) as skipper or crew on the Junior Varsity and Varsity team. Plant High School is one of only two schools in Hillsborough County with an active sailing club and has placed in the top ten at the ISSA Mallory National High School Championships since 2007. DIYSF is proud to provide the students of our area with 420 sailboats and some of the finest coaching available. The Plant High School Sailing Team is part of the South Atlantic Inter-scholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) of the Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association (ISSA), one of seven districts in the United States. Under the



guidance of DIYSF sailing coaches, students practice the skills necessary to be competitive in sailing events around the state and nationally. Students interested in joining the sailing club should contact the PHS Sailing Club Representative, Cora Boroff, and the DIYSF Parent Advisor, Jim Lehan. The Davis Island Yacht Club enthusiastically supports DIYSF and High School sailing clubs in the Tampa Bay area by offering boats, facilities and access to the waters of upper Hillsborough Bay, as well as generous support of DIYSF fund-raising events as a way of encouraging the sport of sailing and the sailing lifestyle. This club is subsidized solely by DIYSF, a non-profit 501c3 organization, and by tax-deductible donations received from the community. No funding is provided by the School Board of Hillsborough County.

Davis Island Youth Sailing offers membership options for Plant High School students:

Students who would like to try the Plant High school's sailing team must notify the DIYSF Board of Directors of their interest, and request the opportunity to participate as a guest. Once approved, students are invited to sail on one designated weekday after school, for the cost of \$25/per visit, with a maximum of four visits. After four practices, should the student wish to continue utilizing DIYSF facilities and coaching, they must choose either a limited or full DIYSF membership. **For more membership information log on to <http://www.diyc.org> and select Youth Sailing.**

Additional Information: All guest and membership fees are payable to Davis Island Youth Sailing Foundation (DIYSF) and are billed quarterly. Either Full or Limited membership requires a \$25.00 annual family membership fee. A \$250.00 refundable damage deposit is required for boat use. All students must provide DIYSF a copy of their birth certificate and health insurance card, and must have a signed code of conduct agreement and liability waiver on file with DIYSF to be eligible to sail. ISSA membership and regatta fees are separate from DIYSF fees and are the responsibility of the PHS Sailing Club. Any fees required by Plant High School for club membership are separate from the fees listed here, and it will be the responsibility of the student to be in compliance with Plant High school requirements.
